

Admission Criteria for St Angela's Ursuline School, 2025-2026

The purpose of this letter is to consult with you on our proposed admissions arrangements for the academic year 2025-2026. The consultation period will run from Monday 11th December to Monday 22nd January 2024.

In accordance with the DfE's 2021 statutory 'School Admissions Code' guidance, as a school we must consult on our admission arrangements when changes are proposed, and at least once every seven years. We are contacting all those with whom we are required to consult in accordance with the Government's School Admission Code and also a number of other interested parties.

St Angela's Ursuline School is proposing the following change to its admission arrangements:

We are consulting to amend our admissions oversubscription criteria.

What change is being made?

The Governing Body of St Angela's Ursuline School are **removing** from all over-subscription criteria the request for any evidence related to what level of practice of that faith their child/family undertake.

Why is this change being made?

The Governing Body of St Angela's Ursuline School are undertaking this change to align the admission criteria(s) of the school with changes made to the CES (Catholic Education Service) national model admission policies.

In accordance with statutory DfE guidance, the consultation will run for at least six weeks and, as an interested party, we are keen to hear your views on the current admission arrangements. Therefore, we invite you to participate in the consultation if you have any concerns regarding the matter.

All responses to the consultation should be made in writing and submitted before 3.00pm on Monday 22nd January 2024 to office@stangelas-ursuline.co.uk. Please label the email's subject as "Admissions Consultation".

Please note that written responses should outline your personal details, including your name, address, and relationship to the school. You are also encouraged to provide feedback to Newham Council here: kentonlineadmissions@kent.gov.uk

At the end of the consultation period, the Governing Body will meet to consider responses. The outcome of the consultation will be published on the school website as soon as possible following decision being reached by the Governing Body.
