- 6 Show cooperation and collaboration by working sensibly with other people
- 7 Demonstrate independent learning skills by doing your best, both in classwork and homework, in order to progress to the highest level
- 8 Think carefully when expressing views and opinions and always respect the views of others
- 9 Respect students’ lives both inside and outside of school by not participating in bullying or antisocial behaviour at any time
- 10 Make sure your words and actions do not embarrass, humiliate or intimidate anyone and that you model the school motto of Serviam



Teachers - Live the Motto

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- 1 Be passionate about your subject
- 2 Be punctual and plan lessons that stretch and challenge your students and enable them to reach their full potential
- 3 Mark your students’ work regularly and provide feedback that helps them improve and make the expected progress
- 4 Decide on seating arrangements that will help maximise learning in your classes
- 5 Communicate both positive comments and issues of concern with students’ parents, through postcards, phone calls, reports and parents’ evenings
- 6 Show an interest in students as individuals
- 7 Listen to any concerns and provide support and guidance if students are finding things difficult or have a problem
- 8 Follow through with appropriate rewards and sanctions.
- 9 Provide a safe, caring and Catholic learning atmosphere in the context of the school’s motto of Serviam
- 10 Make sure your words and actions do not embarrass, humiliate or intimidate anyone and that you model the school motto of Serviam
