Good afternoon,

Consultation on admissions arrangements for 2026-2027 - St Angela's Ursuline School

As Head Teacher, I am writing to advise you that the Governing Body wishes to consult on amending our admissions arrangements for 2026-2027.

The consultation period will run from Friday 13th December 2024 until Friday 24th January 2025; during this time, parents and other interested parties are invited to express their views and any concerns about admission arrangements at St Angela's Ursuline School.

In accordance with the DfE's 2021 statutory 'School Admissions Code' guidance, as a school we must consult on our admission arrangements when changes are proposed, and at least once every seven years.

St Angela's Ursuline School is proposing the following changes to its admission arrangement:-

We are consulting to amend our admissions oversubscription criteria. We propose to clarify the school's position on applicants who's minister/religious leader can not confirm their membership. (6.2 and 7.2).

- 6.1 Children of other Christian denominations whose membership is evidenced by a minister of religion.
- 6.2 Any other Christians
- 7.1 Children of families of other faiths whose membership is confirmed by their religious leader.
- 7.2 Children of any other faiths

In accordance with statutory DfE guidance, the consultation will run for at least six weeks and, as an interested party, we are keen to hear your views on the current admission arrangements.

All responses to the consultation should be made in writing and submitted before 3.00pm on Friday 24th January 2025, through the online survey available here. This constitutes the consultation under the requirements of the legislation.
